A discussion of the Landscape Architecture (LA) proposal produced the following questions or comments:

In the Question and Answer document provided by LA (page 2) it currently states that "Students with a BLA will be accepted directly into the MLA." It is the understanding of the Council that this statement is incorrect and should read that students with a BLA will be accepted directly into the doctoral program.

The following minor modifications to the proposal were also requested: clarification of why the budget for GTFs goes down after the fourth year of the program; and in Appendix A (page 23) a correction to the credit requirements for LA 605 or 606 from "(2-8)" to (3-9).

A motion to approve the proposal for the initiation of a doctoral program in Landscape Architecture and recommend it to the Office of the Provost was passed unanimously.
