Gordon,

Your proposed presentation is misleading (as is Dave's statement regarding the meeting in that both fail to acknowledge the DoJ requirement that "...the statutory faculty members must reserve to themselves the ability to withdraw or modify that delegation.")

You quote from the Opinion: " ' the statutory faculty probably may delegate all or part of its ORS 352.010 powers to a separate body such as the Assembly'..."

The section you quoted (Section 5b of the Opinion) reads: "In sum, the statutory faculty probably may delegate all or part of its ORS352.010 powers to a separate body such as the Assembly that consists of persons who act on behalf of the University. **But the statutory faculty members must reserve to themselves the ability to withdraw or modify that delegation .**" (emphasis added by me)

I trust you will rectify this omission.
