Dear Dr. Sayre:

Dr. Stahl is correct that the faculty should be informed that the statutory faculty must retain its ability to modify or withdraw any delegation.

To modify "any" delegation rather clearly means that any decision made under delegated power must be capable of being overridden. The AG opinion did not limit itself to total withdrawal, but specified also the lesser power of modification.
