Last September, Khurram Parvez was scheduled to appear at a session of the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva to discuss the ongoing crisis of Kashmir. Parvez, an influential Kashmiri human rights advocate and a founder of the <u>Jammu Kashmir Coalition of Civil Society</u> (JKCCS), appeared at the New Delhi airport for his flight only to be detained and barred from leaving the country.
