- Vegetation Management – site assessments, monitoring, and site maintenance
- Plant Community & Vegetation Monitoring – data collection, sampling, and analysis
- Native Plant Nursery work: seed collection, propagation, inventory management

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Completion of three years of college or university coursework in biology, botany, ecology, fisheries, stream ecology, geology, geography, or related fields
- Ability to work in field and on the water (field gear will be supplied by SWM)
- Ability to effectively use computer for data entry and management, report writing and documentation.

- Ability to report to Snohomish County SWM in Everett, Wa. for work
- Approval of internship and credits by faculty advisor
