Excel: You will need access to Microsoft Excel to complete this course. Either on your personal computer or using a University of Oregon computer on campus.

Coursework: Each week homework assignments will be due at 6pm on Friday.

There will be one in-class 70 minute midterm exam scheduled for Monday, May 7.

The comprehensive Final exam is scheduled for Monday, June 11 at 3:15pm.

The exam dates and times are not negotiable and there will be no make-up exams or quizzes. No late homework will be accepted. In case of illness, or a conflict with a sanctioned university activity or event, special arrangements will be made.

Note on Homework: There will be homework assignments each week. The homework will have two components: Online using WeBWork and an Excel assignment that will be submitted electronically on Blackboard.

You will be able to access WeBWork at http://webwork.uoregon.edu/webwork2/ by choosing the math 243 section corresponding to your discussion leader's name. Log into the course using your DuckID (i.e. the first part of your email) as your username, followed by your student ID number (your 950 or 951 number) as your password.

Your assignments using Excel will be submitted through the corresponding assignment on Blackboard. When submitting your Excel file the name must be [last name]_[first name].xls. **Please** note: Do not use the .xlsx file format.

Note on Quizzes: Your lowest quiz grade will be dropped when calculating your final grade.
