\* Directions to Many Nations Longhouse:

**From Portland and the North:** From I-5 South, take Exit 194B onto I-105 West. Take Exit 2, keep left and follow the signs to the UO. Proceed in the left lane over the Ferry Street Bridge, exiting onto Broadway, which becomes Franklin Boulevard. Follow Franklin Boulevard to Agate Street. Turn right onto Agate. Turn right onto 13th Street and stop at the information kiosk to obtain a parking permit for Lot 34E (cost is \$5.00). Once back on Agate, proceed south and turn left onto 17th Street. Turn left at Columbia Street. The Longhouse is at the end of this short street. Parking is in the lot to the east (right) of the Longhouse.

**From Ashland and the South:** From I-5 North, take Exit 192. Merge onto Franklin Boulevard. After merging, get in the left lane and follow Franklin Boulevard through two lights. (Look for a "UO Next Left" sign as you drive west on Franklin Boulevard.) At the third light, turn left onto East Thirteenth Avenue. Proceed two blocks to the four-way stop sign at Agate Street. Proceed straight on 13th Street and stop at the information kiosk to obtain a parking permit for Lot 34E (cost is \$5.00). Once back on Agate, proceed south and turn left onto 17th Street. Turn left at Columbia Street. The Longhouse is at the end of this short street. Parking is in the lot to the east (right) of the Longhouse.
