
02 DISCUSSION



Notes Group 1:

- 1. Representatives from Alliance of Happy Atheists, Students of Ethical Treatment for Animals did not show up.
- Survival Center (SC) and Student Insurgent (SI) Program are very much tied, the two function very much together late night sending publication to press. Does not belong in Media Center, or near Oregon Daily Emerald, Oregon Commentator, and no mainstream news.
- 3. Currently in a suite 779 sq ft, each group is assigned 194 square feet.
- 4. Rather have independent space, ideologically different co-editors, non-hierarchical, everyone has an equal say.
- 5. (SI) Space for three desks, computers Archival space.
- 6. Shared library between Insurgent and Survival Center, space also like radical meeting space SETA. Storage for archives and back papers.
- 7. Space to empower students to activism, encourages students to write about things they're passionate about
- 8. Flexible space to create space types as needed like the shared library
- 9. Survival Center 3 co-directors
- 10. Insurgent 5 co-editors
- 11. Won't have more than 5 at one time in the combined area.
- 12. Affinities to MCC, usually in similar campaigns, would like to build more collaboration with the MCC
- 13. Safe space, lockable
- 14. Less walls within the space is desirable
- 15. Survival Center political, constantly redefining what belongs under the Survival Center banner: Sustainability environmentalism, social justice, overlap a little like on environmental issues, not aligned entirely with Survival Center.
- 16. Insurgent magazine, pamphlet, video, etc... Depends on people's skills
- 17. Located further away from ASUO....like seeing themselves to the right or left of the women's center or the LGBTQA.
