## 02 DISCUSSION – SUSTAINABILITY CENTER

- a. Space standards for workstations and offices were presented and reviewed.
- b. NSF areas and quantities for staff positions were selected. The quantities were kept to a minimum, but there is a concern for future growth.
- c. The open work area should be a flexible multi-use space with a work table, couches, lounge, and floor space with rearrange able furniture.
- d. There are potential sound issues if two groups are working simultaneously in the space. A partition or acoustical separation would be nice.
- e. The existing space has a Sustainability Wall with plants and natural light. It is a demonstration wall, glassed with lath over existing brick walls. It is in a space that was formerly an ice cream parlor. It is now a showcasing earthen wall.
- f. The standard local storage room (36 sf) was presented. The Sustainability Center staff will catalogue their existing storage items to see if they fit in a 5'x7' storage room.

03 DISCUSSION – SURVIVAL CENTER

- a. Gregg Lobisser recommends that the Survival Center be listed in the program. It currently is not listed in the program.
- b. The goal of the Survival Center is not to become an addendum to another space. It should maintain its own identity and have its own door. It is a resource center for student activism.
- c. The Survival Center is currently located in the lower level of the EMU, and shares space with five different groups.
- d. The main need of the Survival Center is flex multi-use space with couches and furniture. The space should also include a work table, lounge area and open floor space.
- e. In its existing location, there are 6 computer stations, posters and an art area.
