

- 3. A reception area with a 3 seat waiting zone is required. The reception area is staffed by a student who is located in the general open space. The student is the first responder to anyone who comes in.
- 4. Enclosed Student workstation room double as a multi-use space that can also be used for Saferide in the evenings.
- 5. Library shelving should be in their lounge space.
- 6. Change dedicated conference room to lactation room with a sink and full size refrigerator. Need changing table, pack-n-play, couch, lounge chairs. 120 sf.
- 7. Storage needs:
  - a. 1 local @ 36 sf
  - b. Add toy cabinet in lounge.
  - c. Remote storage 100 sf
- 8. Lounge has a flat screen prefer wall mounted
- 9. Copiers none in space, has printer in area.
- 10. Students for Choice, Saferide, SWAT
  - a. Students for Choice philosophically is different from Women's Center
  - b. Safe ride should move to 24 hour zone
  - c. SWAT sexual violence prevention education has permanent year round staff, director 100 sf, 1/2 graduate student 36 sf (lockable desk)
- 11. Students for Choice staff
  - a. 2 @ 20 sf




