SITE PLAN 1/16" = 1'

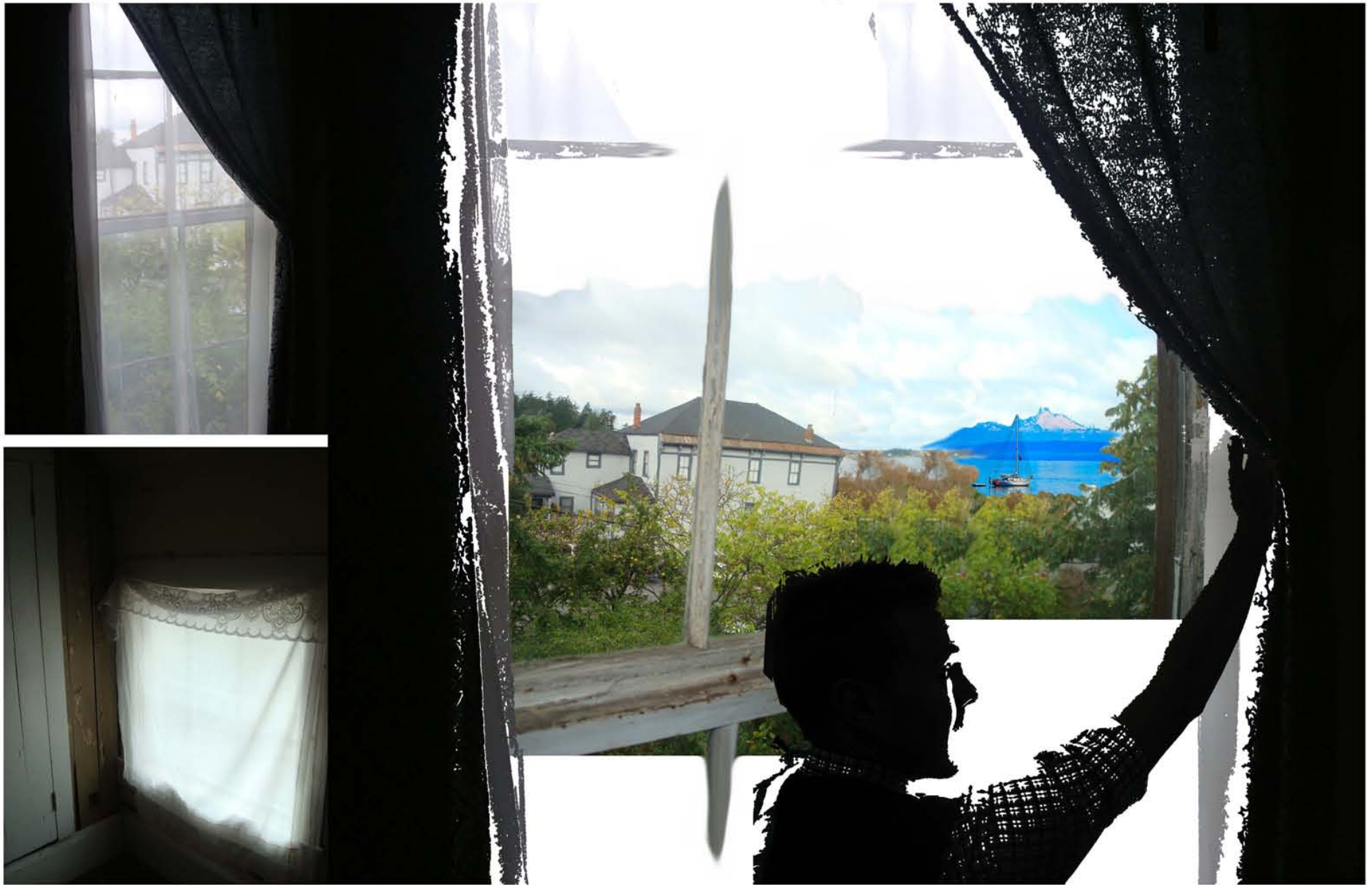
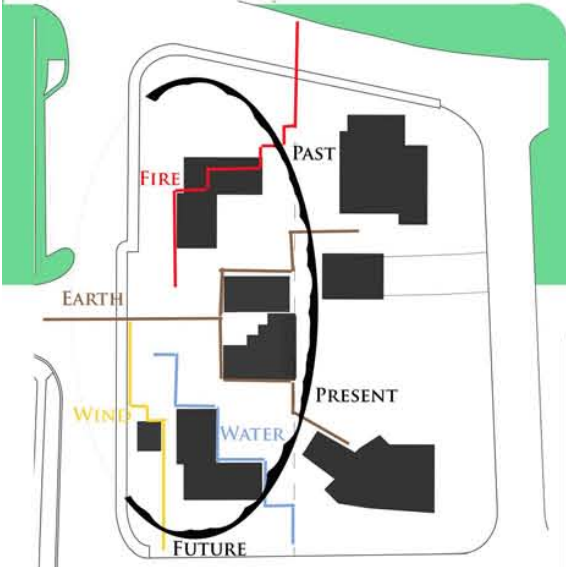
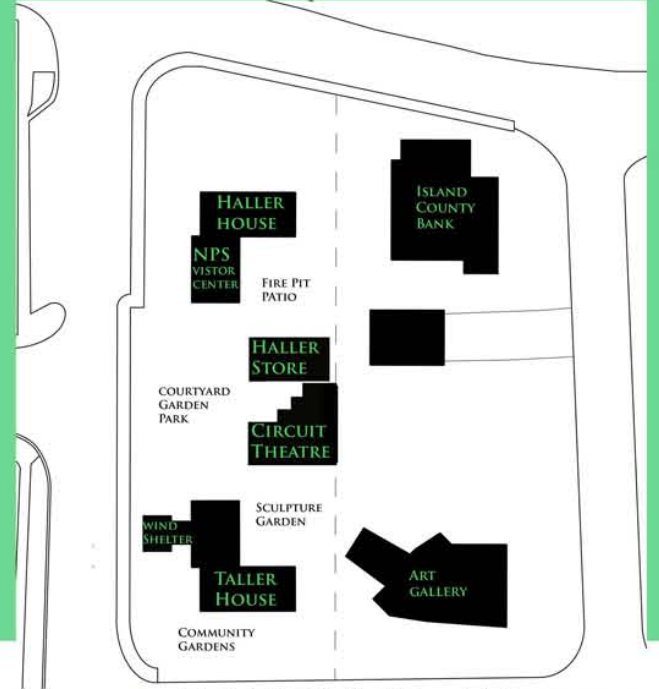
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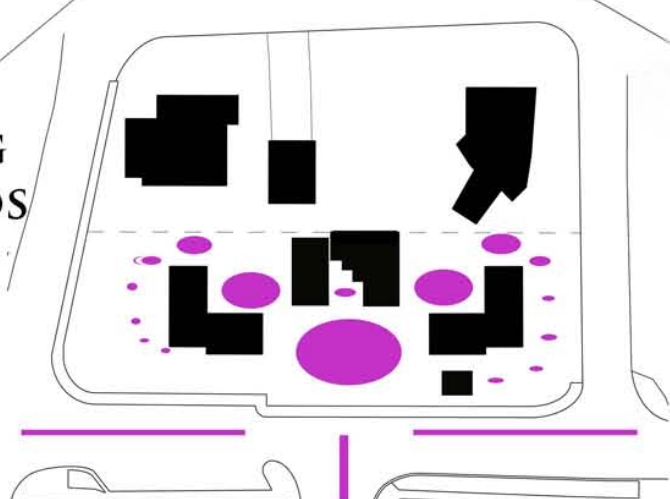
THE HALLER HOUSE WAS ONE OF COUPEVILLE'S EARLIEST HOMES, BUILT IN 1866. THE HALLER STORE WAS SOON ADDED TO THE HOUSE ONLY TO BE CUT IN HALF BY THE WIDENING OF MAIN STREET IN 1889. THE HALLER HOUSE BECAME COUPEVILLE'S FIRST THEATRE, THE CIRCUIT, IN THE EARLY 1900S. THE HOUSE CAUGHT FIRE IN 1940. FIRE QUICKLY CLIMBED THE VERY FLAMMABLE BOX AND PLANK CENTRAL WALL. ALTHOUGH THE HOUSE'S SPINAL CORD WAS BURNT, THE SHELL AND SPIRIT REMAINED. IN 2010 A NEW TYPE OF FISSURE WILL SPLIT THE HALLER HOUSE ONCE AGAIN AND LEAVE ITS MARK IN THE ARC OF TIME; THE SIGNATURE OF SUSTAINABILITY.
