

George Rebec Prize

The Philosophy Department is now accepting submissions for the 2011 George Rebec Prize for the best essay by a philosophy student.

There are two separate prizes of \$100 available, one for a **graduate student** and the other for an **undergraduate student** in Philosophy.

The essay will typically be a paper that you have written for a philosophy class; however, it is not limited to such an essay. Papers need to be typewritten, double-spaced, and **must not exceed 20 pages** in length. Please indicate on the paper that it is a submission for the **Rebec Prize**. Please note that each student may only submit one paper.

The graduate award decision will be made by the faculty members currently serving on the Graduate Studies Committee; the undergraduate award decision will be made by the faculty members currently serving on the Undergraduate Studies Committee.

If you are interested in being considered for this prize, please supply **two** copies of your essay to TK Landázuri in the Philosophy Department office, no later than Monday May 16.
