

The UO Sexual Violence and Institutional Betrayal Survey: Spring 2015 (with Replication using HSP during AY 2015-16) – PART B (AY 2015-16 Packet)

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We administered a campus violence and institutional betrayal survey in late spring 2015. This second survey included -- but was not limited to -- a full pilot of the [ARC3 Survey](#). - **Abstract:** Numerous research studies suggest that at least one in five female college students is sexually assaulted while enrolled. However, many studies exploring sexual violence prevalence on campus use methodology permitting students to self-select into the study based on interest in the topic (i.e., students receive an email offering them the opportunity to participate in a study on sexual violence). Self-selection may bias these prevalence estimates of campus sexual violence. To explore this issue, we surveyed two samples of college women on their experiences of sexual assault. We recruited Sample 1 in a typical way: by emailing a randomly selected subset of students provided by the university registrar and inviting participation with information about the survey topic. We recruited Sample 2 using a human subjects pool where students in introductory psychology and linguistics courses sign up for studies without prior knowledge about the topic of the research they will participate in (hence greatly minimizing the risk of self-selection). The two samples yielded nearly identical victimization rates. Over a quarter of participants in both our samples had experienced sexual contact without consent, consistent with recent research from the Association of American Universities. College victimization estimates do not appear to be biased by self-selection based on knowledge of the survey topic.

Consent

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Welcome. You are invited to participate in a study being conducted by graduate researcher Marina Rosenthal and professor Jennifer Freyd. Please read this form carefully before agreeing to take part in this study.

The purpose of this research is to learn more about experiences UO students may have had. In particular, we are interested in experiences and attitudes related to sexual violence.

If you choose to participate in this study, we expect that it will take you no more than 60 minutes to complete the survey. As a part of this study, you will be shown a variety of statements and questions in the form of a questionnaire and asked to answer them. These questions will ask about topics unwanted sexual and romantic events you may have experienced. Your participation is voluntary and you are free to discontinue at any point. Due to the sensitive nature of these questions, there is some psychological risk associated with participating in this study. However, this risk does not go beyond those that may be encountered in daily life. If you agree to participate in this study, you may skip any questions that you wish without penalty. There will be a series of items throughout the survey to check that you are devoting attention and care to your survey responses. Such items may ask "For this question, select 5."

Given that this study will ask you a variety of questions about illegal behavior, keeping your responses confidential is our highest priority, however it cannot be completely guaranteed. We do not have access to your IP address and will make no attempts to discover your identity.

This study will take no more than 60 minutes to complete and must be completed in one session. You will be awarded 1 credit for your participation. If you choose to discontinue participation at any point after clicking through the consent page, you will receive .5 credits. If you discontinue participating in the middle of this study, contact the listed researcher to receive partial credit.

Your participation is voluntary. Your decision whether or not to participate will not affect your relationship with the UO Psychology Department or the UO Linguistics Department. If you decide to participate, you are free to withdraw your consent and discontinue participating at any time without penalty. The Psychology and Linguistics Departments have established alternative assignments for students who do not wish to participate as research subjects. Please see your instructor if you would rather complete an alternative assignment.

No information you provide in this survey will be linked to your identity in any way. While researchers do not have access to individual responses, SONA administrators have a record of your participation in the study for the purposes of issuing class credit.


