

#### **Opening & Closing Receptions:**

The Institute will open with a reception on Monday evening to be followed by our opening keynote session in the Knight Law Center on the UO campus. Seminars will begin the next morning and will be held in the Knight Law Center. There will be a closing reception on Saturday evening.

#### **Transportation to Eugene:**

The easiest route is usually to fly directly into Eugene airport (EUG). From EUG, OmniShuttle provides door-to-door shuttle service to and from EUG. The shuttle kiosk is located near the baggage claim area at the south end of the terminal. For more information or to make a reservation, contact OmniShuttle by phone at 1-800-741-5097. A taxi from EUG is typically only a little bit more than the OmniShuttle (and much more efficient, especially if you can find someone to buddy with). It is easiest to arrange a pickup in advance with Oregon Taxi at (541) 484-0920. As an alternative to flying into EUG, you can fly into Portland (PDX) and then either rent a car and drive 125 miles to Eugene or take a shuttle from PDX to UO (use Google to find shuttle companies).

Parking: Currently priced at around \$10/day and available on arrival at the information kiosk located at 13<sup>th</sup> and Agate St..
