*ABOUT TONIGHT'S GUEST ARTIST*

**Bob Washut** is Professor of Music at the University of Northern Iowa, where he served as Director of Jazz Studies from 1980-2002. An accomplished jazz composer and arranger, Washut has received numerous commissions from collegiate jazz ensembles, professional jazz artists, and symphony orchestras. Many of his works are published by the *UNC Jazz Press* (Grealey, CO), *Walrus Music Publishing* (Pismo Beach, CA), C. L. Barnhouse (Oskaloosa, IA), and Heritage Jazz Works (Dayton, OH). Washut is director of the award-winning UNI Jazz Band One, and is in demand as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the country. An active jazz pianist, Washut is founder of the Latin jazz band, *Orquesta Alto Maiz*, and recently recorded and released a jazz trio CD entitled *Songbook* (Sea Breeze Jazz:SB-3036). He was selected as Outstanding Teacher at the University of Northern Iowa in 1996.
