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ABOUT TONIGHT'S GUEST ARTIST

An active performer of both jazz and classical music, **Idit Shner** has played in various distinguished venues in the United States and abroad, such as The Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. and Lincoln Center in New York. An avid classical saxophonist, Shner has commissioned and recorded new music and performed solo recitals in the U.S. and Israel.
