ABOUT TODAY'S GUEST ARTIST

David Constantine is a finalist in this year's Percussive Arts Society (PAS) International Solo Timpani Competition, and was awarded the PAS Cloyd Duff Scholarship in 2002. He is currently the principal timpanist of the Columbus Indiana Philharmonic, and Associate Instructor of Percussion at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. Constantine performs regularly with the Camerata Orchestra, university ensembles, and is an active recitalist. He has performed in Europe, and throughout the United States under the batons of Marin Alsop, Sylvain Frémaux, Miguel Harth-Bedoya, David Bowden, Giancarlo Guerro, James Paul, Leonard Slatkin, and Gerhard Zimmerman. Constantine graduated with a Master of Music degree in percussion performance, with honors, from the University of Oregon under Charles Dowd. He is currently pursuing his Doctor of Music degree in percussion performance at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music with Anthony Cirone and Gerald Carlyss.
