ABOUT TONIGHT'S ARTISTS

Carl Woideck is an instructor of jazz, rock, and blues music histories at the University of Oregon, where he began teaching in 1982. He holds a Master of Science degree (interdisciplinary: music, education, and ethnic studies) and a Bachelor of Music degree (composition) from the University of Oregon. Woideck is also a professional saxophonist and longtime jazz radio broadcaster.

Idit Shner is assistant professor of jazz and classical saxophone. Shner holds a Bachelor of Music degree from Oklahoma City University, a master's degree in music education from University of Central Oklahoma, and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of North Texas. She joined the UO music faculty in 2005.

Steve Owen is a Philip H. Knight professor of music and director of jazz studies at the University of Oregon. A nationally known composer, arranger, soloist, clinician, and educator, Owen received his B.Mus. from North Texas State University and a M.Mus. degree from the University of Northern Colorado. Prior to joining the UO faculty in 1988 he was assistant director of jazz studies at the University of Texas at Arlington.

Mike Denny is an instructor of jazz guitar. He has been on the UO faculty since 1995 and the Lane Community College faculty since 1994. Denny also works as a clinician for jazz events and seminars at the University of Oregon.

Tyler Abbott is an instructor of double bass, jazz bass, and music theory. He maintains an active performance schedule as an orchestral bassist, chamber musician, jazz bassist, clinician, and soloist, performing throughout the region and nation with some of the finest musicians in both the classical and jazz music worlds.

Josh Hakanson pursued collegiate music studies as a student at the University of Oregon and holds a Bachelor of Music in Jazz Studies. Hakanson has performed and made appearances as a freelance artist with artists such as Benny Green, Gina Saputo, Jessie Marquez, Mark Gould, Idit Shner, Mike Denny, Carl Woideck, Steve Owen, Idit Shner, Toby Koenigsberg, Barney McClure, Hashem Assadullahi, Olem Alvez and Inner Limits, Joe Manis, and The Douglas Detrick Quintet among many others.
