Raised in California and Oregon, she has played the flute since she was in middle school. Julianna performed Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Flute Concerto in G Major with the Eugene Symphony Orchestra in 2009 and Jaques Ibert's Flute Concerto with the University of Oregon Symphony in 2012. She has performed live on KLCC radio and soloed in masterclasses for artists such as Greg Patillo, the beat-boxing flutist. In addition to performing as a soloist, Julianna enjoys orchestral playing and has performed with the Eugene Symphony Orchestra, the training ensemble Orchestra Next, and the University of Oregon Symphony.

Julianna and her twin sister Jenna have played the piano since they were 5 years old. When they are not dueling on the piano, they enjoy playing dual piano pieces.
