Kelly has recently become the newest member of the Oregon Mozart Players cello section, and this summer she will be performing and touring with the Portland Cello Project. In girlhood, Kelly had fallen asleep to the Dvořák Cello Concerto nearly every night (at the objection of her sister) so tonight's performance is literally a dream come true.
