*ABOUT TONIGHT'S GUEST ARTIST*

Drummer **Gary Hobbs** is a native of the Pacific Northwest and lives in Vancouver, WA. He has played professionally for three decades and appears on over 40 recordings. Hobbs appears on recent recordings on the Origin Record Label including: Richard Cole's The Forgotten, Phil Kelly's Convergence Zone, Tim Jensen's A Mind For the Scenery, Randy Halberstadt's Parallel Tracks, as well as his own CD, Of My Times.
