### ABOUT TONIGHT'S GUEST ARTIST

Bob Washut is Professor of Music at the University of Northern Iowa, where he served as Director of Jazz Studies from 1980-2002. He was selected as Outstanding Teacher at the University of Northern Iowa in 1996.
