ABOUT TONIGHT'S ARTISTS

The **Charles Dowd Goodvibes Jazz Duo featuring Tracy Freeze** has released two CDs (manufactured by SONY): "Snapshot Live" (2006) and "Bus Dust & Dogs" (2007). The duo explores improvisation. Original works make up the bulk of the current music explored by Dowd and Freeze, in the genre of the vibraphone-marimba combination. However, the duo continues to draw inspiration from four other jazz duos: Bobby Hutcherson & McCoy Tyner, Gary Burton & Chick Corea, David Friedman & Dave Samuels, and Mike Mainieri & Warren Barnhardt. Both Dowd and Freeze are mallet players performing some of the premier classical compositions written for solo vibraphone and marimba. The jazz collaborations of Dowd and Freeze bring an original voice to this unique genre of the acoustic vibraphone-marimba combination. The improvisations of **Charles Dowd** are born from his iconoclastic recording with Anthony Braxton and performances with Andrew Hill, Vinnie Golia, Bobby Hutcherson, Don Ellis and concerts with John Cage. The improvisations of **Tracy Freeze** stem from the 20th and 21st century tradition of "classical improvisation" of Meyer Kupferman, William Kraft, Frank Zappa and the Blackearth Percussion group. **Doug Scheuerell** is a North Indian tabla drum virtuoso trained in India. He is instructor of tabla at the University of Oregon School of Music and Dance.
