Jonathan also serves as principal cellist of the Oklahoma City Philharmonic and cellist with the Brightmusic Chamber Ensemble in Oklahoma City. He lives in Norman, OK with his wife, violinist Katrin Stamatis, and their daughter, Arianna.
