## **SHOIN STYLE ARCHITECTURE (interior)**

The <u>shoin</u> style flourished in the Momoyama and Edo periods. Its origins may be seen at 15th c. Muromachi-period structures such as the Tōgudō (1486, Jishōji). See Mason, pp. 204-5 and pp. 214-15

Elements used in the **shoin** style include:

tatami fusuma chigaidana tsuke shoin tokonoma (chōdaigamae) (see p. 215)
