Thailand

I was a resident of Thailand on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a United States citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant.

I am visiting the United States for the purpose of teaching or engaging in research at the University of Oregon for a period not exceeding two years. I will receive compensation for my teaching or research activities. Any research I perform will be undertaken in the public interest and not primarily for the private benefit of a specific person or persons.

The compensation received during the entire tax year (or during the period from _____ to _____) for these activities qualifies for exemption from withholding of federal tax under the tax treaty between the United States and Thailand. I have not previously claimed an income tax exemption under that treaty for income received as a teacher, researcher, or student before the date of my arrival in the United States.

The treaty exemption is available only for compensation received during a period of two years beginning on that date.
