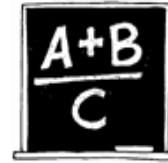

**People's Republic of China**

I was a resident of the People's Republic of China on the date of my arrival in the United States. I am not a United States citizen. I have not been lawfully accorded the privilege of residing permanently in the United States as an immigrant.

I am a visiting professor or teacher in the United States for the purpose of teaching, giving lectures, or conducting research at the University of Oregon, which is an accredited educational institution. I will receive compensation for my teaching, lecturing, or research activities. Any research I perform will be undertaken in the public interest and not primarily for the private benefit of a specific person or persons.

The teaching, lecturing or research compensation received during the entire tax year (or during the period from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_) qualifies for exemption from withholding of federal tax under the tax treaty between the United States and the People's Republic of China. I have not claimed an income tax exemption for income received as a teacher, lecturer, researcher, or student before the date specified in the next paragraph.
