

STEP 1

Simplify the following:
 $x^2 - 3x + 2$

STEP 2

The factors of 2 that sum
to -3 are -1 and -2 .

Answer:

$(x-1)(x-2)$

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$\frac{\sqrt{2.9} - \sqrt{3}}{2.9 - 3}$

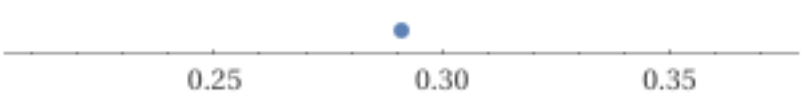
