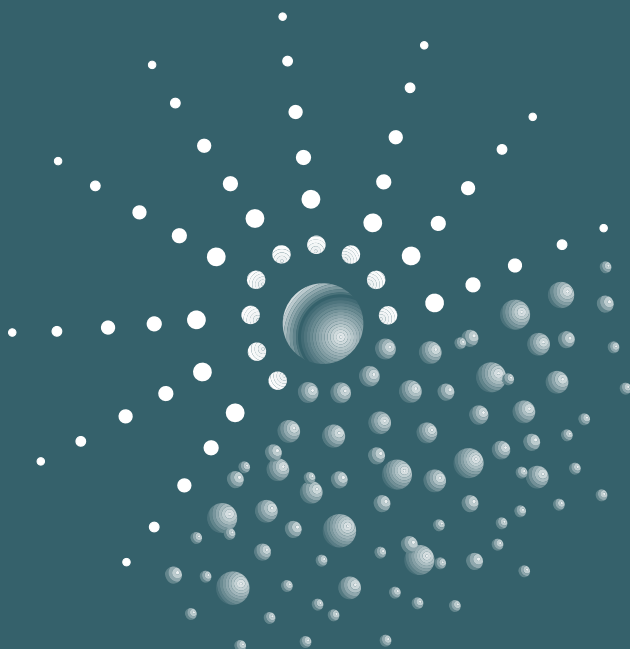
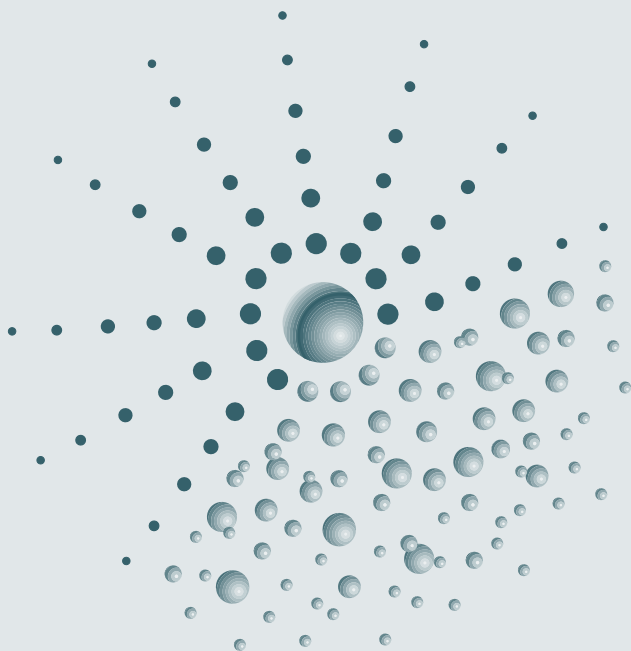


YOUR ELECTRIC AND WATER RATES



EWEB'S NOVEMBER 2005 RATES



For nearly a century, the Eugene Water & Electric Board has provided its customers with high-quality services at reasonable rates. As Oregon's largest citizen-owned municipal utility, we strive to keep you informed about any changes in your electric rates.

We are pleased to inform you that EWEB's Board of Commissioners has lowered your electric rates by 2.46 percent, effective with November 2005 bills. This rate decrease is the result of lower Bonneville Power Administration wholesale electricity costs (EWEB purchases almost two-thirds of its power from Bonneville). EWEB commissioners have a general policy of "passing through" any rate increases or decreases in BPA costs to customers.

This rate decrease will lower the monthly bill of the average residential customer by about \$1.99. Your savings will vary according to how much electricity you use.

There is no change to water and windpower rates.

ELECTRIC SERVICE RATES

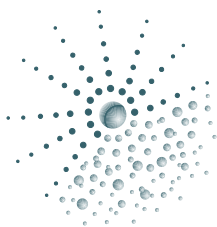
The Residential Electric rate is composed of three monthly charges: the Basic Charge, the Delivery Charge and the Energy Charge.

Services that must be provided to you regardless of your usage, such as meter reading, billing and customer service, are listed under **Basic Charge**.

The **Delivery Charge** covers the costs of all “back-end” work required to send power over EWEB’s distribution system to your home. It includes the operation and maintenance of local wires, transformers, poles and equipment.

The **Energy Charge** covers the costs of producing the electricity and transmitting it over long-distance transmission systems to Eugene’s distribution system. (If you have signed up for EWEB Windpower, it will appear on this portion of your bill.)

General Service rates also include a **Demand Charge**, which charges for peak kilowatt (kW) usage during the billing period.

(November through April billing cycle)

First 800 kWh..... 3.782¢ per kWh

Energy Charge, Summer

(May through October billing cycle)

First 800 kWh..... 3.782¢ per kWh

Next 900 kWh 5.295¢ per kWh

Over 1,700 kWh..... 6.727¢ per kWh

Residential Service Example: (Assumes energy consumption of 1,800 kWh in September)

Basic Charge.....\$6.00

Delivery Charge

1,800 kWh x 2.671¢.....\$48.08

Energy Charge

First 800 kWh x 3.782¢.....\$30.26

Next 900 kWh x 5.295¢.....\$47.66

Next 100 kWh x 6.727¢.....\$6.73

Total Electric Bill.....\$138.73

SMALL GENERAL SERVICE

(0-30 Monthly kW)

Basic Charge

Single-phase service\$11.50 per month

Three-phase service.....\$17.25 per month

Demand Charge

This is set on the highest consumption of power required in any 15-minute period during the billing month.

First 10 kW.....No Charge

All Additional kW.....\$4.792 per kW

Delivery Charge

First 1,750 kWh 4.232¢ per kWh

All additional kWh.....0.156¢ per kWh

Energy Charge.....4.311¢ per kWh

MEDIUM GENERAL SERVICE

(31-500 Monthly kW)

Basic Charge

Single-phase service \$17.25 per month

Three-phase service.....\$26.00 per month

Demand Charge

This is set on the highest consumption of power required in any 15-minute period during the billing month.

All kW.....\$4.792 per kW

Energy Charge..... 4.604¢ per kWh

PRIVATE PROPERTY LIGHTING SERVICE

100-watt lamp.....\$6.05 per month

200-watt lamp.....\$7.80 per month

400-watt lamp.....\$12.90 per month

(Where applicable, a \$1.00 per month pole rental charge is added. Pole rental is not available for new services.)

OTHER CLASSES OF ELECTRIC SERVICE

G-3: Large General Service (501-5,000 kW)

G-4: Very Large General Service (Over 5,000 kW)

J-3/J-4: Customer-Owned Lighting Service

EWEB WINDPOWER

The basic Windpower Energy Charge is 5.274 cents per kilowatt-hour. Customers will see their Windpower option reflected on the Energy Charge portion of their monthly bill as a melded average of the Windpower rate and the non-wind rate.

For example, a customer who chooses the 25 percent Windpower option will pay an Energy Charge of 4.155 cents per kilowatt-hour in the first tier (an average of 25 percent at the Windpower rate of 3.782 cents plus 75 percent at the non-wind rate of 4.051 cents). The second-tier rate for the same 25 percent Windpower customer is 5.290 cents, while the third-tier charge is 6.364 cents per kWh.

The following table lists residential Windpower customers' Energy Charges, by tier, for each Windpower option offered by EWEB.

10% Windpower

First tier.....	3.931¢ per kWh
Second tier.....	5.293¢ per kWh
Third tier.....	6.582¢ per kWh

25% Windpower

First tier.....	4.155¢ per kWh
Second tier.....	5.290¢ per kWh
Third tier.....	6.364¢ per kWh

50% Windpower

First tier.....	4.528¢ per kWh
Second tier.....	5.285¢ per kWh
Third tier.....	6.001¢ per kWh

100% Windpower

All tiers.....	5.274¢ per kWh

WATER SERVICE RATES

Your monthly water bill is composed of three main parts: the Basic Charge, Consumption Charge and an Elevation Charge, if applicable.

The monthly **Basic Charge** is based on meter size and covers the cost of services that must be provided regardless of how much water you use per month. This includes meter reading, billing and customer service.

The **Consumption Charge** applies to the amount of water you use per month and is expressed in thousands of gallons, or “kgals.”

The **Elevation Charge**, if applicable, recovers the cost of pumping water to higher-elevation customers.

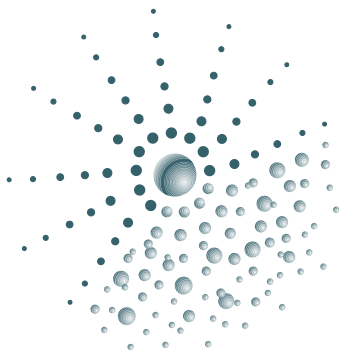
