♦ Performance Majors are required to take 5 credits of upper division music courses. These may be taken any term.

※ Due to major code restriction of the Bachelor of Music degree, second and third Arts & Letters courses may not have MUS or MUJ subject code.

*To earn 180 total credits required for the Bachelor's degree, students may need to earn additional college credit as specified.
