The Department of Languages, Philosophy, & Speech Communication at Utah State University invites applications for a tenure-track, Assistant Professor in Philosophy. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate courses, maintaining a substantive research agenda, and performing service to the university. AOS: Ethics and Ethical Theory. AOC: Applied Ethics, Political Philosophy, or Philosophy of Law. Must have interest in teaching Introduction to Philosophy. The University is dedicated to recruiting candidates from a diverse pool including women, minorities, veterans, and people with disabilities, and is sensitive to the needs of dual-career applicants. Located in a mountain valley 80 miles north of Salt Lake City, USU is a Carnegie Research-Extensive University with a growing enrollment of over 20,000 students. Review of applications will begin January 7, 2011, and the position will remain open until filled.

Responsibilities Teach courses in Philosophy. Conduct and publish scholarly research. Advise and mentor undergraduate students. Serve in various departmental committees as needed.

Minimum Qualifications Doctorate in Philosophy completed by August 2011. ABD considered at Instructor rank until Ph.D. is completed (Ph.D. would have to be completed within one year of hire date)

Preferred Qualifications

- (1) Area of Specialization: Ethics and Ethical Theory; Area of Competence: Applied Ethics, Political Philosophy, or Philosophy of Law;
- (2) Interest in teaching Introduction to Philosophy;
- (2) Demonstrated ability to conduct and publish scholarly work;
- (3) Demonstrated ability to effectively teach in area of specialization and area of competence;
- (4) Ability and willingness to mentor undergraduate students;
- (5) Ability to compliment the current strengths of the department.

- (1) A curriculum vita
- (2) A cover letter expressing your interest in the position
- (3) Evidence of teaching effectiveness, such as recent teaching evaluations
- (4) A sample of research.
