This independent study course is available based on instructor consent and includes work on special projects, especially lab analysis in archaeology, under the direction of Ayres or, sometimes, an advanced student. Content varies, but basic laboratory methods, such as cataloging, drawing, and quantitative analysis of artifacts, or other research methods are covered. Students may sign up for variable credit (1-8 credit hours) using the CRN number set up for a specific academic term.
